The HAPPI innovation platform where suppliers may submit their innovative solutions for healthy ageing has opened on September 24th. To help you in the submission process, an online tutorial has been developed for you by BITECIC.

The tutorial covers the following subjects: overview of the homepage, how to create a supplier account, how to login, create and save your submission and check the status of your submission. What is the HAPPI innovation online platform?

This platform offers suppliers an opportunity to showcase their innovative products to the HAPPI project ahead of any calls for tender and formal procurement process. The information submitted for this market survey will be used in preparation for the pilot joint European call for tender of June 2014.

Submitting your innovative offer in the HAPPI platform is also an opportunity to inform the buyers about your products for future tenders that they might launch individually. Please bear in mind that 7 purchasing bodies have already joined the network!

What is the deadline to submit innovative solutions?

Suppliers have until **mid January 2014** to participate in the market survey for the pilot call for the tender of 2014. However, the platform will stay open afterwards remaining a sustainable source of information for any calls for tender that may follow. Furthermore, the HAPPI network is expanding to other healthcare procurement organisations from Europe who regularly visit the platform, increasing the visibility of the submitted innovations at European level.
